### What is the Human Race?

The Human Race is a community fundraiser. It provides an opportunity for any and all 501c3 organizations serving McHenry County to raise dollars for their programs. It also allows individuals, groups, and businesses to support the organization of their choice.

Participating organizations receive 60% to 90% of monies collected in their name. Not-For-Profit Resources receives the remaining percentages to coordinate the event and continue to promote volunteerism in McHenry County.

Race Day includes a 5K run/walk; top fundraising awards, and lots of fun.

All participating organizations are invited to the Celebration Breakfast in June where checks and prizes are handed out to organizations.

- April 15, 2010: The Human Race will take place at McHenry Industrial Park
